Consider embarking on leisure time activities, or perhaps following one of the many mountain trails, or diving into optional activities like kayaking, fjord sightseeing, or even venturing to the remarkable Stegastein platform. The stage is set for unforgettable fun amidst Norway's scenic beauty.

DAY 10 FLAM TO BERGEN

Then it’s time to hop on board and cruise along Aurlandsfjord, gliding into the World Heritage-listed Naroyfjord –Europe’s slimmest fjord! Naroyfjord is like a slice of fjord heaven with its epic waterfalls and charming farms on the steep slopes. As our boat docks in Gudvangen, we hop on a private motorcoach to complete this epic journey all the way to Bergen.

DAY 11 BERGEN

Tucked between cosmopolitan and small-town allure, Bergen, the charismatic “Capital of the Fjords,” crafts a refined blend of experiences with a hint of playfulness. We join our local guide on a walking tour this morning. Immerse yourself in Bryggen, a UNESCO World Heritage treasure, and its impeccably preserved historical homes, narrating tales of eras gone by. The cheerful fish and flower market adds a modern twist to tradition, buzzing with an energy that transcends time. Elevating the experience are the cable cars that unveil stunning vistas. Later, opt to hop on the Floibanen Funicular to Mound Floyen for a panorama that’s Instagram-worthy, or take a cable car ride to Mt Ulriken, where sophistication meets thrill. For the culture enthusiasts, Bergen’s museums are gems that speak volumes, telling stories of history, maritime legacy, architectural brilliance, and the contemporary avant-garde. For the night owls, Bergen’s hip nightlife scene is centered around the streets of Engen and Vetrilidsallmenningen, where you’ll find an array of trendy bars, live music venues, and laid-back lounges, making it the perfect spot to unwind and have a blast after dark.

All land package rates are based on two people sharing a room. You can book a single-room by paying an additional single supplement of \$575 for the 9-day land package or \$1,000 for the 12-day land package.

If you are a solo traveler and don’t want to pay the single supplement, AESU will attempt to arrange a share with a same-gender traveler. If we are unable to arrange a share, the single supplement will be added to your invoice.
